School Uniform Policy

The teachers and principal of Kingsland N.S. in conjunction with the Board of Management and parents have formulated this policy.

Description of uniform;

- Navy blue trousers and navy sweater with crest with light blue shirt. (Navy tie is optional).
- Tracksuit, (Navy) No stripes/ logo's/ No Hoods with light blue polo shirt.
- No Football shirts.
- Girls may wear the above or navy skirts; pinafores and cardigans are also acceptable.
- Denim is not any part of the school uniform.
- The only jewellery permitted is watches, stud earrings and medical bracelets.
- No make-up is to be worn by pupils.
- Jackets are not permitted to be worn in the classroom.
- No high heel shoes allowed.
- For Hygiene and Health & Safety, children with long hair are asked to Tie it Up.
- Parents will be contacted to collect children if uniforms get soiled during school.

Note

Children are to wear the school uniform for the following.

- To school every day including P.E. days.
- School Photographs.
- Confirmation ceremonies.
- School events.
- Selected Church events.

Parents are requested to provide a note if a child is unable to wear the school uniform on any day. Children who fail to adhere to our policy will be sanctioned as per our code of discipline, which includes adhering to school uniform.
